# Financial Literacy Programs



## Financial Reality Fair

We led a financial literacy experience at Pāhoā High School and Waiākea High School, bringing together students, CU Hawai'i staff, and community volunteers.

Through hands-on, real-life budgeting scenarios, students chose a career and were given a financial profile that included income, family responsibilities, and expenses.

They rotated through stations making decisions like purchasing a car or choosing phone plans, with the goal of managing their money, saving, and planning for retirement.

At the end, students reviewed their budgets to see whether they stayed on track or went into debt, gaining practical insight into real-world money management.

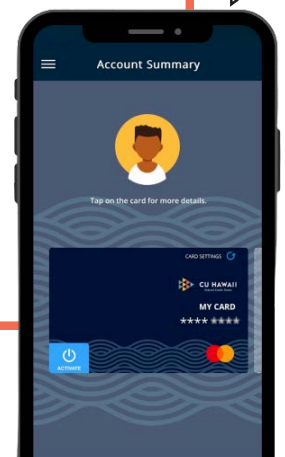


## HOW TO SPOT SCAMS?

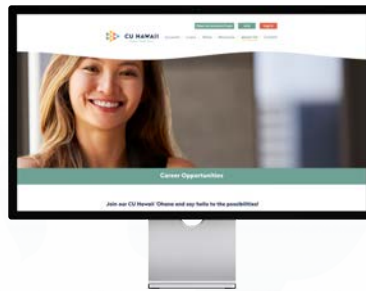
